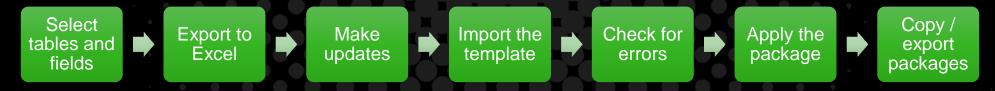

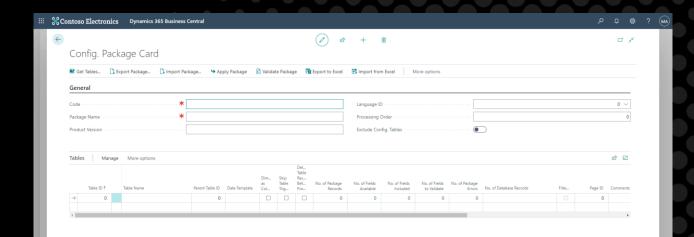

Common Uses (Import/Export)

Supplemental Data (Lookups)

- Payment Methods
- Payment Terms
- Shipment Methods

Master Data

- Customers
- Vendors
- Items
- Fixed Assets
- Contacts
- Jobs

Subsidiary Data (Drill-Downs)

- Item Prices/Costs
- Vendor Items
- Customer Alternate Addresses

Open Transaction Data

- Sales/Purchase Documents
- Journal Lines

TIPS & TRICKS EXPORTING PACKAGES





Exporting Configuration Packages

"Exclude Config. Tables"

- Enable to prevent the inclusion of questionnaire, worksheet, and template table data
- Otherwise, the additional tables may be confusing

"Dimensions as Columns"

Enable to include all Dimensions Codes as additional columns

Config. Package Filters

• To limit or eliminate records during export





Export to Excel

- Do NOT mess with the worksheets (or with Texas)
 - Tip from Erik Hougaard
 - The package links to the BC table via a hidden excel field
 - To maintain the integrity of worksheet:
 - Do not:
 - Modify ANY table headers
 - Modify ANY column structure or order
 - Modify ANY worksheet structure or name
 - Etc.!!
 - Only update the data inside the table.
 - Otherwise you'll confuse the system.





TIPS & TRICKS IMPORTING PACKAGES





Importing Configuration Packages

- Try imports in a test company first!
- Config. Package Fields
 - Validate Field
 - Processing Order
 - Same order you would manually populate the page
 - Create Missing Codes
 - Mapping





Clean Data - Best Practices

- Eliminate non-printing characters
 - Especially control characters (TAB, CR, LF, etc.)
 - Use CLEAN() in Excel
- Avoid ambiguous symbol characters
 - Like: !@#\$%&*()|
 - Especially in Code fields





Clean Data (Use Excell)

- Top ten ways to clean your data (microsoft.com)
- Merge data from other sources
 - VLOOKUP()
- Remove non-printing characters
 - CLEAN()
- Text, not Formulas!





Table Processing Rules

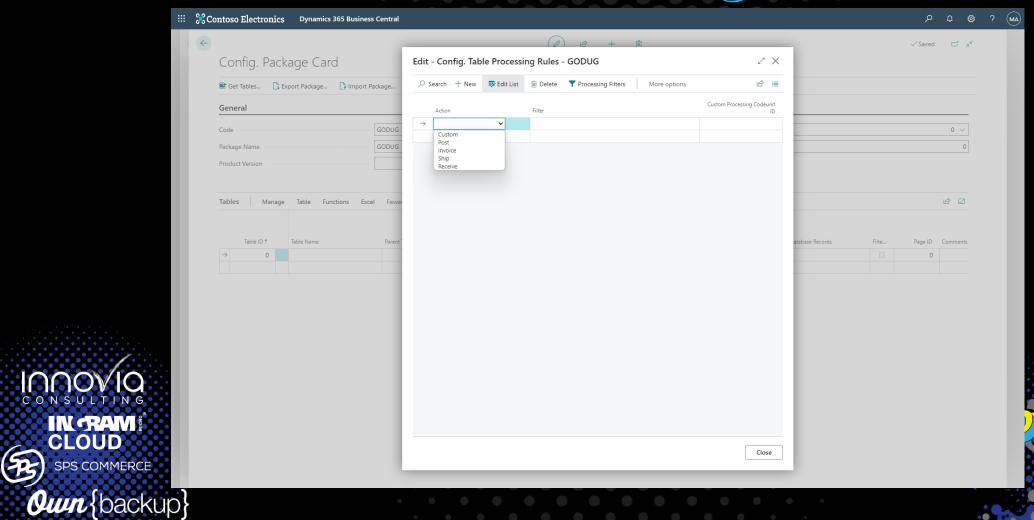


Table Processing Rules

- Sales Header
 - Invoice, Ship
- Purchase Header
 - Invoice, Receive
- General Journal Line, General Journal Batch
 - Post
- Custom Report Layout
 - Post inserts into "Report Layout Selection"
- Transfer Header
 - Ship, Receive
- **Item**
 - Post runs codeunit "Setup Item Costing Method"





Gotchas

Apply headers before lines

- Manually control the order via Functions > Apply Data
 - i.e. after importing, select the header table and apply it first, then apply whole package

To remove a bad import:

 Export again, delete all data but the first line, then re-import with "Delete Table Records Before Processing" checkbox enabled – this will delete all table records but the one



MORE TIPS & TRICKS

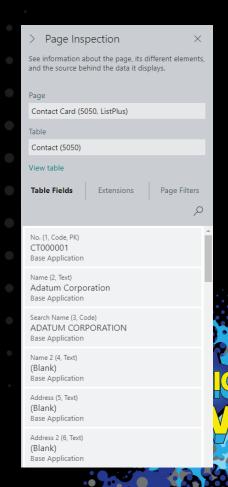






- Only use the necessary fields
 - BC will autofill / calculate some fields and you can accidentally overwrite these with incorrect data.
- Not sure which fields you want? ALT + CTRL + F1
 - Open Page Inspection on a record and review what's there





Edit .rapidstart File

- Export to .rapidstart
- Unzip with .7zip
- · XML!
- Edit XML
- Zip with gzip format
